STANNARD BEGINS WITH A PORTRAIT OF THE ENORMOUS RICHNESS AND DIVERSITY OF LIFE IN THE AMERICAS PRIOR TO COLUMBUS'S FATEFUL VOYAGE IN 1492. BUILDING ON THE THEMES OF SOCIETAL SELF-DEFENCE DEVELOPED IN EARLIER WORKS, FOUCAULT SHOWS HOW DEFINING "NORMALITY" BECAME A PREROGATIVE OF POWER IN THE NINETEENTH CENTURY, SHAPING THE INSTITUTIONS—FROM THE PRISONS TO THE FAMILY—MEANT TO DEAL WITH "MONSTROSITY," WHETHER SEXUAL, PHYSICAL, OR SPIRITUAL.
