Flying Scotsman Fred Kerr 2016-11-30 Built at Doncaster works in 1923 the Nigel Gresley designed then-A1 class Pacific (4-6-2) first entered service as No 1472. The new locomotive did not receive a name until it was sent for display at a Wembley exhibition in 1924, and then the name Flying Scotsman was chosen. The Legend was born.
