Use in heart failure: evidence for benefits and harms of digoxin is conflicting and of lower quality; most but not all of the evidence concerns use in heart failure with reduced ejection fraction (HFrEF). There is strong evidence for other agents as first-line therapy to reduce hospitalizations and mortality in adults with HFrEF.
