Campanian Ignimbrite. The authors, for their interpretations, utilize thermodynamic and quantitative mass balance modelling of major and trace element data and semi-quantitative limits on Th and Sr isotopes to evaluate the role of crystal-melt separation, magma-fluid interaction, and assimilation of wallrock on the geochemical evolution of the Campanian Ignimbrite.
