It is intended to replace the sermon or Liturgy of the Word, or stand alone. Pageant 2 "A Child of Might" – This production is based on medieval "mystery plays" with static staging that is easier than in pageant 1. However it does use archaic English and requires memorization. It does not include the Magi, but introduces several characters not usually found in other pageants. Pageant 3 "People, Look East" – This version presents a dramatized service of Lessons and Carols for Advent and Christmas. It features nine scripture readings, each followed by a carol or hymn (with performance options). Children mime the readings. It is intended to be an entire Sunday liturgy (includes communion). *Go Tell It On the Mountain* is also available as a downloadable product on the Church Publishing website.
