Dialogue with Europe, Dialogue with the Past Justyna Olko 2018-11-30 Dialogue with Europe, Dialogue with the Past is a critical, annotated anthology of indigenous-authored texts, including the Nahua, Quechua, and Spanish originals, through which native peoples and Spaniards were able to convey their own perspectives on Spanish colonial order. Each document and its accompanying commentary provide additional insight into how the nobility negotiated everyday life.
