THE LETTERS OF WILLIAM LLOYD GARRISON WILLIAM LLOYD GARRISON 1981 WILLIAM LLOYD GARRISON (1805-1879), OUTSTANDING AMONG THE DEDICATED FIGHTERS FOR THE ABOLITION OF SLAVERY, WAS ALSO AN ACTIVIST IN OTHER MOVEMENTS SUCH AS WOMEN'S AND CIVIL RIGHTS AND RELIGIOUS REFORM. NEVER TIRING IN BATTLE, HE WAS 'IRREPRESSIBLE, UNCOMPROMISING, AND INFLAMMATORY.' HE ANTAGONIZED MANY, INCLUDING SOME OF HIS FELLOW REFORMERS. THERE WERE ALSO MANY WHO LOVED AND RESPECTED HIM. BUT HE WAS NEVER OVERLOOKED.

TRAVELLERS THROUGH EMPIRE CECILIA MORGAN 2017-11-08 IN THE LATE EIGHTEENTH CENTURY AND THROUGHOUT THE NINETEENTH CENTURY, AN UNPRECEDENTED NUMBER OF INDIGENOUS PEOPLE – ESPECIALLY HAUDENOSAUNEE, ANISHINAABEG, AND CREE – TRAVELLED TO BRITAIN AND OTHER PARTS OF THE WORLD. WHO WERE THESE TRANSATLANTIC TRAVELLERS, WHERE WERE THEY GOING, AND WHAT WERE THEY HOPING TO FIND? CECILIA MORGAN RETRACES THEIR VOYAGES FROM ONTARIO AND THE NORTHWEST FUR TRADE AND DETAILS THEIR EFFORTS OVERSEAS, WHICH INCLUDED POLITICAL NEGOTIATIONS WITH THE CROWN, RAISING FUNDS FOR MISSIONARY WORK, RECEIVING AN EDUCATION, GIVING READINGS AND PERFORMANCES, AND TEACHING INTERNATIONAL AUDIENCES ABOUT INDIGENOUS CULTURES. AS THEY TRAVELLED, THESE REMARKABLE INDIVIDUALS FORGED NEW FAMILIES AND FRIENDSHIPS AND LEFT BEHIND NEWSPAPER INTERVIEWS, TRAVELOGUES, LETTERS, AND DIARIES THAT PROVIDE INSIGHTS INTO THEIR CROSS-CULTURAL ENCOUNTERS. CHRONICLING THE EMOTIONAL TIES, CONTEXTS, AND DESIRES FOR AGENCY, RESISTANCE, AND NEGOTIATION THAT DETERMINED THEIR DIVERSE EXPERIENCES, TRAVELLERS THROUGH EMPIRE PROVIDES SURPRISING VANTAGE POINTS ON FIRST NATIONS TRAVELS AND REPRESENTATIONS IN THE HEART OF THE BRITISH EMPIRE.

THE CORRESPONDENCE, 1868-1875 WALT WHITMAN 2007-06 GENERAL SERIES EDITORS GAY WILSON ALLEN AND SCULLEY BRADLEY ORIGINALLY PUBLISHED BETWEEN 1961 AND 1984, AND NOW AVAILABLE IN PAPERBACK FOR THE FIRST TIME, THE CRITICALLY ACCLAIMED COLLECTED WRITINGS OF WALT WHITMAN CAPTURES EVERY FACET OF ONE OF AMERICA'S MOST IMPORTANT POETS. IN DISCUSSING LETTER-WRITING, WHITMAN MADE HIS OWN VIEWS CLEAR. SIMPLICITY AND NATURALNESS WERE HIS GUIDELINES. "I LIKE MY LETTERS TO BE PERSONAL—VERY PERSONAL—AND THEN STOP." THE SIX VOLUMES IN THE CORRESPONDENCE COMPRISE NEARLY 3,000 LETTERS WRITTEN OVER A HALF CENTURY, REVEALING WHITMAN THE PERSON AS NO OTHER DOCUMENTS CAN. VOLUME II PRESENTS THE POET DURING THE YEARS HE WAS DEVELOPING AN INTERNATIONAL REPUTATION. ENMESHED IN A CONTROVERSY THAT REVEALED HIS VIEWS ON RACE, POLITICS, AND JUSTIFIABLE VIOLENCE. FURTHER PRESSURE IS EXERTED ON HIM PERSONALLY BY THE DEATH OF HIS MOTHER SARAH, AND THE NUMEROUS CALLS ON HIM TO SUPPORT RELATIVES IN IRELAND. MICHAEL FARADAY'S DEATH IN AUGUST 1867 ADDS TO THESE DEMANDS, AS TYNDALL ASSUMES FARADAY'S RESPONSIBILITIES AT THE ROYAL INSTITUTION. IN THIS PERIOD, TYNDALL WRITES HIS POPULAR BOOK SOUND, AS WELL AS FARADAY AS A DISCOVERER, HIS MEMORIAL TO FARADAY.
