HOWEVER, THIS SHORT CHAPTER SHOWS THAT THERE IS ACTUALLY MUCH IN COMMON. IN THE FINAL CHAPTER MATTHEW GALAS COMPARES AND CONTRASTS THE SWORD ARTS IN GERMANY WITH THE CLASSICAL JAPANESE MARTIAL TRADITIONS. THE PERIOD COVERED BY THIS INQUIRY REACHES FROM APPROXIMATELY 1350 UNTIL 1600. THE FOCUS IS ON GENERAL PRINCIPLES AND COMBAT PHILOSOPHY.
