Natural regeneration following harvesting or during post-agricultural succession has often failed to restore these forests adequately. Similarly, reforesting areas that were once natural forests will also require new silvicultural knowledge. Global warming trends will intensify the need for interventions to maintain the diversity and function of temperate hardwood forests, as well as for increase hardwood reforestation.
