Severe cough, runny nose, apnea (a pause in breathing in infants) Pneumonia (infection in the lungs), death Polio IPV vaccine protects against polio. - 1 in 10 people with measles will get middle ear or lung infections
- 1 in 1,000 people will get encephalitis (swelling of the brain), which can lead to seizures, deafness, or brain damage
