IS THAT ANY TIME PEOPLE, ACROSS THE POLITICAL SPECTRUM, START TO FEEL THAT FREEDOM IS THREATENED, THE BOOK EXPERIENCES A RIPPLE OF WORD-OF-MOUTH INTEREST. AND THAT INTEREST HAS NEVER BEEN MORE PROMINENT OR POTENT THAN WHAT WE'VE SEEN IN THE PAST YEAR. *THEY THOUGHT THEY WERE FREE* IS AN ELOQUENT AND PROVOCATIVE EXAMINATION OF THE DEVELOPMENT OF FASCISM IN GERMANY.
