BRADEN SCALE For Predicting Pressure Sore Risk - Indiana

SENSORY PERCEPTION – Ability to respond meaningfully to pressure-related discomfort 1.

COMPLETELY LIMITED Unresponsive (does not moan, flinch, or grasp) to painful stimuli, due to diminished level of consciousness or sedation, OR limited ability to feel pain over most of body surface. 2.

–VERY LIMITED – Responds only to painful stimuli ...

Learning Disability - persons who, although normal in sensory, emotional and intellectual abilities, exhibit disorders in perception, listening, thinking, reading, writing, spelling, and arithmetic.
