A lo largo de estas páginas se ocupará, en primer lugar, de definir los crímenes de lesa humanidad, destinados a legitimar la responsabilidad penal de los autores de atrocidades cometidas a cubierto de regímenes políticos exasperantemente nacionalistas y autoritarios. Leonor Esteves, actualmente, es Profesora Coordinadora en el área de Derecho en el Instituto Politécnico de Viseu y Profesora Invitada en la Faculdade de Direito, Escola de Criminologia, Universidade do Porto, también, investigadora en el Centro de Investigação Justiça e Governação, JusGov, da Escola de Direito da Universidade do Minho y en el Centro de Estudos Jurídicos Económicos e Ambientais, CEJEA, de la Faculdade de Direito da Universidade Lusíada.
