**The Captives of Abb's Valley** James Moore 2012-12 A tragedy of Virginian colonial frontier In the summer of 1786 a large war party of Shawnee Indians

entered Abb's Valley, Virginia, and descended on the household of militia officer Captain John Moore which included members of his immediate family together with hired labourers. Two young women survived their ordeals to eventually be ransomed. The story of this notable frontier tragedy was written by James Moore, a son of Mary Moore, who was one of the two ransomed captives.
