Bad Boy from Jamaica Basil Wayne Kong, Ph.D., JD 2014-05 Garnett Myrie came into this world on 27 September 1953 and grew up in the hills of St. Elizabeth, Jamaica. When his uncle went to the United States as a farm worker in 1960 and brought back Black liberation literature, he became enamored with "Black Power".
