The six works included in the section called "EXPERIMENTAL STUDY DESIGNS" analyze EEG alterations in the protocols: Electroocortical activity in dancers and non-dancers listening to different music genre and during imaginative dance motor activity; Electroocortical activity during monosynaptic reflex in athletes; Monitoring of electroocortical activity for evaluation of seasickness; Electroocortical activity in different body positions; Electroocortical activity in athletes and non-athletes during body balance tasks; Electroocortical responses in volunteers with and without specific experience watching movies including the execution of complex motor gestures. In the section called "OTHER INTERESTING THINGS" were included one work that analyze EMG (electromyography) alterations in pathological and healthy subjects in the protocol: Comparison between clinical diagnostic criteria of sleep bruxism and those provided by a validated portable holter. The described procedures can be used for clinical trials, although the studies proposed in this work do not refer to samples from pathological subjects. With its multi-specialist approach, through many theoretical and practical feedback, this work will be useful for specializing in neuroscience, statistics, engineering or physiology.
