Letters from Kartini Kartini (Raden Adjeng) 1992 "The freeing of women is inevitable -- it will come, only we cannot hasten its coming. The freedom of women will be the fruit of our suffering and pain, " wrote Ajeng Kartini in 1903. She did not live to see that freedom, but today she is counted among Indonesia's heroes and is honored by a national holiday, Kartini Day.

Letters of a Javanese Princess Kartini (Raden Adjeng) 1985 Translated from the original Dutch by Agnes Louise Symmers and originally published by Alfred A. Knopf, this collection of letters was written by the daughter of a Javanese civil servant in the Dutch colonial government. She had been permitted the unusual privilege of attending a Dutch elementary school, but then returned home to seclusion during her adolescence, as was the Indonesian custom for women. The letters provide a fascinating picture of the life and spirit of the time during the period when Java was undergoing intimate contact with Western civilization. Dari mulai yang tidak masuk akal, sampai yang seolah-olah dikemas dengan bungkus ilmiah. Diantara paham yang merusak itu adalah; Sekularisme, Pluralisme, dan Liberalisme, yang biasa disingkat dengan SEPILIS. Mereka berusaha mendekonstruksi syariat, bahkan dengan cara-cara yang sangat ekstrim. Misalnya dengan mengatakan bahwa Islam adalah agama opolosan, finalitas kenabian Muhammad Shallallahu Alaihi wa Sallam perlu ditinjau ulang, Al-Qur'an adalah produk budaya, dan lain sebagainya yang sangat menyimpang jauh dari keyakinan Ahlu Sunnah wal Jamaah. Umat Islam menyebut kelompok ini sebagai "Kelompok Liberal", bukan "Islam

Liberal". Karena, Islam bukan liberal, dan liberal bukan Islam. Islam tak butuh embel-embel, tak butuh kata sandingan yang bisa mereduksi ketinggian nama dan kehormatannya sebagai ad-din yang datang dari Allah Subhanahu wa Ta'ala. Islam itu tinggi, dan tak ada yang mampu melebihi ketinggian ajaran-ajarannya. Mereka yang silau dengan peradaban barat dan ideologi buatan manusia, akan menganggap bahwa Islam itu kurang sempurna, sehingga perlu ditambah, dikurangi, bahkan kalau perlu dipermaak sesuai selera hawa nafsunya. Gagasan mengenai Indonesia Tanpa Liberal adalah sah-sah saja, selama ide itu didasari pada dalil yang kokoh, pada studi dampak dan pengaruhnya pada masyarakat.

Sebagaimana negara ini bisa melarang komunisme, maka liberalisme pun bisa dilarang jika ada political will pemerintah. Tinggal bagaimana umat Islam bisa melakukan pressure terhadap pemerintah dan menyadarkan masyarakat akan bahaya ideologi "Sepilis Global" yang diimpor dari barat, kemudian dipasarkan oleh para pengasongnya di negeri ini. Buku ini mengulas sepak terjang kelompok liberal, latar belakang berdiri dan background para aktivisnya, serta sejarah panjang kampanye pluralisme agama di Nusantara yang sudah ada sejak ratusan tahun lalu, terutama sejak orang-orang Eropa datang ke negeri bersamaan dengan kolonialisme, yang kemudian memasarkan paham humanisme. Kalau dulu orang lebih mengenal istilah sinkretisme keyakinan, sekarang dikenal dengan sebutan pluralisme agama. Similarly, as in industrialized nations, Third World professional women are over-represented in such professions as nursing and teaching. Divisions between women's and men's work have obvious economic and political implications. Evidence of gender inequality and exploitation of women exist in most societies, yet some of the worst cases are found in the developing world. The murder of some five thousand women annually in India by dissatisfied husbands;

the enslavement of women working in Pakistan's brick-making industry; wife beatings in Zambia and the Andes; and the sale of child brides are only a few of the many instances of women's subservient status in many Third World countries. Less dramatic examples of gender inequality include divorce laws that favour husbands; the restricted opportunities for women's employment in universities, the professions, and higher-paid blue-collar jobs; and the double day that women must frequently face (coming home from a long day's work and having to do all the housework and child care). After years of neglect, many international agencies and government planners have begun to recognize women's special status and needs in development projects. The book brings together information on women's and weaker sections of education and development, reviews research results for each developing region, identifies gaps in current knowledge, and discusses problems of methodology.

Seeing Beauty, Sensing Race in Transnational Indonesia L.
