AS A SORORITY, IT WAS FORMED TO BRING WOMEN TOGETHER AS SISTERS, BUT AT THE SOME TIME TO ADDRESS THE DIVISIVE, OFTEN CLASS-RELATED ISSUES CONFRONTING BLACK WOMEN IN OUR SOCIETY. THERE IS, IN GIDDINGS'S EYES, A TENSION BETWEEN THESE GOALS THAT MAKES DELTA SIGMA THETA A FASCINATING MICROCOSM OF THE STRUGGLES OF BLACK WOMEN AND THEIR ORGANIZATIONS. MYERS 2020-12-08 OVER THE LAST TWENTY YEARS, NUMEROUS SCHOLARLY PUBLICATIONS HAVE TREATED THE WORK OF AFRICAN AMERICAN ARTISTS OF THE 1950S, 1960S AND 1970S. AT THAT TIME, DETROIT WAS THE FIFTH LARGEST CITY IN THE COUNTRY WITH A LARGE AFRICAN AMERICAN POPULATION AND A VIBRANT BLACK ARTS SCENE. NEVERTHELESS, THE AFOREMENTIONED PUBLICATIONS FAIL TO DISCUSS DETROIT AFRICAN AMERICAN ARTISTS. THIS BOOK, WHICH ACCOMPANIES AN EXHIBITION OF THE SAME TITLE, FOCUSES ON THE LIFE AND WORK OF MEMPHIS BORN, DETROITER HAROLD NEAL, WHO CREATED SOME OF THE MOST FORCEFUL ARTISTIC STATEMENTS OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS AND BLACK POWER MOVEMENTS.
