Utilizing a portfolio management framework throughout an application's lifecycle will provide the necessary structure to ensure that all new applications are properly evaluated, and, once implemented, remain relevant while continuing to meet organizational requirements. While an organization may have a few large "organization-wide" systems such as the Electronic Health Record (EHR), lab or radiology systems, they also have a large quantity of other clinical, administrative, and research systems. Some larger organizations now have hundreds of software applications to support and manage. The IT staff must be able to implement new requests while still maintaining the current application portfolio. Utilizing a standard repeatable process will help to manage these large portfolios of software applications. This book reviews the management of applications throughout their lifecycle, from initial request through disposition. Best practices dictate that every newly requested application undergoes analysis followed by an approval decision from the organization's governance committee. The initial implementation project must include activities to prepare for ongoing support while ensuring the application is compliant with all security, privacy, and architecture requirements. An application spends years in operations and maintenance where changes occur regularly through configuration and release management, or additional projects. The cycle continues until disposition. Understanding when to dispose of an application is just as important as deciding when to implement a new one. A defined process for disposing of an application ensures all parts are properly removed or destroyed.

White 2013 The authors are presently in the fourth year of a six-year, lottery-based randomized control trial (RCT) studying the effectiveness of nine Colorado charter schools that have implemented Core Knowledge'. Core Knowledge (CK) is a comprehensive K-8 curriculum for language arts, math, science, social studies, visual arts, and music that is intended to build knowledge, concepts, and vocabulary systematically from one grade to the next, leading to substantial progress in reading. The purpose of this paper is to describe (1) a particular set of problems that arose in conducting the lottery-based RCT and (2) the solutions that we developed and implemented. The nine participating CK charters are located in six school districts that range from the suburbs south of Denver to the city of Fort Collins in the north. The participants include two cohorts of students and their parents who participated in kindergarten entrance lotteries in 2010 and 2011. Students are being tracked as they progress from kindergarten to third or fourth grade when they will take Colorado achievement tests in reading, mathematics, and writing in 2014 and 2015. In the third year of the project the authors conducted a small parent survey to assess the feasibility of individually testing Cohort 1 students in a

non-school setting. The parent survey not only gave the authors access to Cohort 1 students for testing but also proved to be a valuable source of data in its own right. In fact, although it was not included in the original proposal, they have come to view it as an integral part of the lottery-based RCT, indeed the key to plans for Years 4-6. They will repeat the survey and testing process with Cohort 2.
