Bidirectional Gene Promoters Fumiaki Uchiumi 2022-11-01 Recent studies in human genetics and in silico analyses have revealed that a number of genes are head-head orientated with other genes or non-coding RNAs. The expression of regulatory element-containing 5'-upstream regions of gene pairs are referred to as bi-directional promoters and are thought to have a key role in biological regulatory mechanisms. For example, tumor suppressor protein-encoding TP53 and BRCA1 genes are head-head bound with WRAP53 and NBR2, respectively. DNA-repair factor-encoding ATM and PRKDC (DNA-PKcs) genes have bidirectional partner NPAT and MCM4, respectively. Surveillance of the human DNA database has revealed that the numbers of DNA repair/mitochondrial function/immune response-associated genes are bound with other genes that are transcribed to opposite direction. The observations may encourage us to investigate in the molecular mechanisms how DNA repair/mitochondrial function/immune response-associated genes are regulated by bidirectional promoters. Not only protein-coding genes, but also quite a few ncRNAs, which play important roles in various cellular events, are transcribed under the regulation of the bidirectional promoters. More importantly, we know that dysregulation in the promoter activity and transcription initiation of genes might cause human diseases.

Hans Ibeles in London Johanna Kinkel 2017-11-17 Johanna Kinkel, geborene Mockel / geschiedene Mathieux (8. Juli 1810 in Bonn - 15. November 1858 in London) war eine deutsche Komponistin, Musikpädagogin, Schriftstellerin und Salonière. In zweiter Ehe war sie mit dem evangelischen Theologen und politisch aktiven Republikaner Gottfried Kinkel verheiratet, mit dem sie den bekannten späromantischen Dichterkreis Maikäferbund gründete. Sie galt als Mittelpunkt des kulturellen Lebens ihrer Heimatstadt Bonn, ist die einzige bedeutende Vertreterin der Bonner Mundartdichtung des 19. Jahrhunderts und war eine frühe Vorkämpferin der Frauenrechtsbewegung. Bei der Niederschlagung des letzten badischen Aufstands, der auch das endgültige Scheitern der Märzrevolution von 1848/49 in den Staaten des Deutschen Bundes markierte, wurde Gottfried Kinkel vom preußischen Militär verhaftet und zu lebenslänglich Zuchthaus verurteilt. Bei der Vorbereitung der Befreiung ihres Mannes aus dem Zuchthaus in Spandau spielte Johanna Kinkel eine zentrale Rolle. Sie organisierte finanzielle Mittel, die für die Befreiungsaktion nötig waren, und übermittelte dem inhaftierten Gottfried Kinkel die Befreiungspläne. Ausgeführt wurde die Befreiung durch Carl Schurz, der Gottfried Kinkel in der Nacht vom 6. auf den 7. November 1850 in einer spektakulären Aktion aus dem Zuchthaus herausholte. Schurz und Kinkel flüchteten zusammen über Rostock und von dort nach Warnemünde. Am 17. November 1850 reisten sie von dort mit dem Schiff nach Edinburgh in Schottland, wo sie am 1. Dezember 1850 ankamen. Im Januar 1851 folgte Johanna Kinkel mit ihren vier Kindern ihrem Ehemann nach London ins Exil. Kurz vor ihrem Tod beendete sie ihren Roman *Hans Ibeles in London*, der posthum 1860 von ihrem Mann Gottfried veröffentlicht wurde. In 1862, he founded a school that is now Keio University. In the late 1870s, he turned his attention to the prospects for parliamentary government in Japan. The central government was firmly in place and elective prefectural assemblies were about to be established. He wrote essays on the workings of
