HE HAS TAUGHT AT TRINITY COLLEGE DUBLIN AND THE UNIVERSITY OF LIVERPOOL AND IS CURRENTLY A TEACHING FELLOW AT DURHAM UNIVERSITY.

THE REJECTION OF CONSEQUENTIALISM SAMUEL SCHEFFLER 1994-08-11 IN CONTEMPORARY PHILOSOPHY, SUBSTANTIVE MORAL THEORIES ARE TYPICALLY CLASSIFIED AS EITHER CONSEQUENTIALIST OR DEONTOLOGICAL. STANDARD CONSEQUENTIALIST THEORIES INSIST, ROUGHLY, THAT AGENTS MUST ALWAYS ACT SO AS TO PRODUCE THE BEST AVAILABLE OUTCOMES OVERALL. STANDARD DEONTOLOGICAL THEORIES, BY CONTRAST, MAINTAIN THAT THERE ARE SOME CIRCUMSTANCES WHERE ONE IS PERMITTED BUT NOT REQUIRED TO PRODUCE THE BEST OVERALL RESULTS, AND STILL OTHER CIRCUMSTANCES IN WHICH ONE IS POSITIVELY FORBIDDEN TO DO SO.
