The Afterlives of the Terror Ronen Steinberg 2019-09-15 The Afterlives of the Terror explores how those who experienced the mass violence of the French Revolution struggled to come to terms with it. He argues that it was the same democratizing, radicalizing dynamic that led to the violence of the Terror, which also gave rise to an unprecedented interrogation of how society is affected by events of enormous brutality. In this sense, the modern question of what to do with difficult pasts is one of the unanticipated consequences of the eighteenth century's age of democratic revolutions.
