PSYCHOSOCIAL RISKS AND HAZARDS REPRESENT THOSE ASPECTS OF THE WORKPLACE, SUCH AS THE JOB DESIGN AND THE ORGANISATION AND MANAGEMENT OF WORK THAT HAVE THE POTENTIAL TO CAUSE HARM OF A PHYSICAL AND/OR PSYCHOLOGICAL NATURE TO THE INDIVIDUAL (COX & GRIFFITH, 2005; INTERNATIONAL LABOUR ORGANIZATION, 1986; LEKA & COX, 2008).
