ROBERT LOWELL HAS RECENTLY WRITTEN, "I AM SURE NO LIVING POET IS AS CURIOUS AND OBSERVANT AS MISS BISHOP. WHAT CUTS SO DEEP IS THAT EACH POEM IS INSPIRED BY HER OWN TONE, A TONE OF LARGE, GRAVE TENDERNESS AND SORROWING AMUSEMENT.
