THE DYNAMIC INTERACTION OF THE PERFORMING ARTS GAVE RISE TO A SET OF MUSICAL CONVENTIONS THAT INFORMED MOLIERE'S THEATRE AS WELL AS EARLY FRENCH OPERA.

ACQUIRING CULTURE (PSYCHOLOGY REVIVALS) GUSTAV JAHODA 2015-03-27 UNTIL THE 70S AND 80S ANTHROPOLOGISTS STUDYING DIFFERENT CULTURES HAD MAINLY CONFINED THEMSELVES TO THE BEHAVIOUR AND IDEA SYSTEMS OF ADULTS. PSYCHOLOGISTS, ON THE OTHER HAND, WORKING MAINLY IN EUROPE AND AMERICA, HAD STUDIED CHILD DEVELOPMENT IN THEIR OWN SETTINGS AND SIMPLY ASSUMED THE UNIVERSALITY OF THEIR FINDINGS. THEIR EXPERIENCE AND FOCI OF INTEREST WERE VARIED BUT THIS VERY DIVERSITY SERVES TO ILLUMINATE DIFFERENT FACETS OF THE ACQUISITION OF CULTURE BY CHILDREN, RANGING IN AGE FROM PRE-VERBAL INFANTS TO ADOLESCENTS. EVOLUTIONARILY PRIMED FOR CULTURE-LEARNING, CHILDREN ARE RESPONSIVE TO A RICH WEB OF INFLUENCES FROM SUBTLE AND INDIRECT AS IN THEIR MUSIC AND DANCE TO DIRECT TEACHING IN THE FAMILY GUIDED BY CULTURE-SPECIFIC IDEAS ABOUT CHILD PSYCHOLOGY. SOME OF THE SALIENT THINGS THEY LEARN RELATE TO GENDER, STATUS AND POWER, CRITICAL FOR THE FUNCTIONING OF ALL SOCIETIES.
