Con el tiempo pasamos a centrarnos en otro término más amplio, pero también más inclusivo, el de Enseñanza Comprensiva del Deporte, y ha terminado, creemos que con mejor criterio, en *Investigaciones en Formación Deportiva*, todavía más amplio, pero que precisa de una manera más adecuada lo que pretendemos con la enseñanza del deporte. El primer capítulo es introductorio, y no hace más que reflejar una reflexión de las personas que coordinamos esta obra, también en discusiones, foros, publicaciones, y que nos llevan a tener una idea sobre cómo debería ser la Formación Deportiva, sin que ello impida tener una visión crítica.
