The book has come about because of the scarcity of the type of books I want to use to teach the essentials of English to secondary school students who are learning English as a second language in an environment in which contact with the English language is minimal. This is a book with a difference: it is reader-friendly and uncluttered. It has illustrations in Chinese to flag ideas of special interest to help readers to avoid the types of errors commonly made by students. It aims to help them grasp the basics of English and the practical aspects of its usage. Poetry being the soul of any language, part of this book discusses poetic measures, the appreciation of poetry and what is new in poetry today. This book, a labour of love, is also about caring and sharing. To promote the practical use of good English is what I care about. I think Hong Kong will be a better place for it. Thus, in preparing the contents of this book, regard has been taken of the variations and changes to the language that have taken place through globalization and advances in modern technology and the various innovations currently on the market.
