The aim of this book is to describe in detail the latest understanding of the pathophysiological mechanisms involved in the three main aspects of contact

dermatitis (irritation, allergy and urticaria), to then encapsulate modern approaches to the evaluation of chemical hazards in this area by critically reviewing the test methodologies involved, and finally to illustrate how the risks presented may be assessed.
