His mother always taught him he was a link in a chain, thousands of people long, stretching back hundreds of years. But, as his brother First says, he's getting tired of chains. Irreverent and written with Auslander's incomparable humor, *Mother for Dinner* is an exploration of legacy, assimilation, the things we owe our families, and the things we owe ourselves.
