**The Dogs of the Sinai** Franco Fortini 2013 "Fortini/Cani" presents Fortini reading excerpts from his book, focusing on his alienation from Judaism and social relations, the rise of fascism in Italy, and the anti-Arab attitude of European culture. The Italian landscape provides a backdrop that highlights the meaning of the text.

**At the Crossroads of the Earth and the Sky** Gary Urton 2013-12-18 Above Misminay, the sky also is so divided by the alternation of the two axes of the Milky Way passing through the zenith. This mirror-image quadri-partition of terrestrial and celestial spheres is such that a point within one of the quarters of the earth is related to a point within the corresponding celestial quarter. The transition between the earth and the sky occurs at the horizon, where sacred mountains are related to topographic and celestial features. Based on fieldwork in Misminay, Peru, Gary Urton details a cosmology in which the Milky Way is central. This is the first study that provides a description and analysis of the astronomical and cosmological system in a contemporary community in the Americas. Separate chapters take up the sun, the moon, meteorological phenomena, the stars, and the planets. Star-to-star constellations, the "animal" dark-cloud constellations that cut through the Milky Way, and certain twilight- and midnight-zenith stars are analyzed in terms of their spatial and temporal integration within an indigenous cosmological framework. Urton breaks new ground by demonstrating the indigenous merging of such forms of "precise knowledge" as astronomy, meteorology, agriculture, and the correlation of astronomical and biological cycles within a single calendar system. More than sixty diagrams clarify this Quechua system of astronomy and relate it to more familiar principles of Western astronomy and cosmology.

My way of proceeding is always the same: we take the best of tradition and develop it, so as to enable it to express its full potential. In the second part we focus on the particular importance of the stars which rise or set heliacally, cosmically or achronically on the day of the spring Equinox or on the days around it. As we'll see, even the stars in paran with the equinoctial Sun have greater strenght. It will be shown how these stars influence the characteristics and

events of an epoch. In the third part we talk about some stellar influences that mark the great stages of human history and the epochal changes. Among these there is not only the change of precessional era, but also the change of the polar star and the stars and constellations which reach the points of minimum and maximum declination over the millennia. In particular, we focus on some possible ways of calculating the precessional eras based on the constellations, and not on the zodiac signs. We will see that a new age takes place by stages, and therefore these methods are not mutually exclusive, as each can lead us to dates that mark periods in which some characteristics and events of the new age become more evident. We will verify this by studying the start dates and events of the age of Aries, Pisces, and especially Aquarius ... The fourth part is focused on a technique for locating world events, based on the stars and constellations that rule a certain place, but also on the planets. It is a new technique that I have recently developed, but always using traditional principles and techniques. I have applied it to dozens of world events with excellent results. Obviously, first of all, we will explain how to identify stars, constellations, signs and planets which are in sympathy with a certain nation, and so rule it.
