The MHO is assisted by the nurses as supervisors, with midwives as the prime providers of immunization services. The need to confirm the diagnosis in the laboratory impacts our understanding of the occurrence of salmonellosis. To be laboratory confirmed: 1) the patient has to seek medical care, 2) a specimen has to be collected (while the patient is still shedding the organism), and 3) appropriate laboratory tests/cultures must be performed.
